Greetings Parent, Guardians, and Children:

We are at the start of another season and the staff at Harakati Inc. and El Cariso Park are excited about the many opportunities and possibilities to enrich your child’s life through positive interaction in the Harakati Kidz STEM Summer Day Camp Program. We have planned sports, arts & crafts, group games, computer lab, outdoor play, indoor gym play, experiments, presentations, holiday celebration, and snack/lunch program to ensure your child has an AWESOME Summer Break. However, with any program comes rules, regulations & consequences – these are not meant to put a damper on the fun, but they are needed to keep things in order, running smoothly and to ensure that when you drop your most precious possession off you know he/she is in a safe environment.

Rules, Regulations & Consequences:

1. Children will arrive and/or be picked up within 5 minutes of the hours of Summer Camp operation: (Monday – Friday 7:30am to 6:00pm) **-no child should be dropped off without staff being present –**
2. Parent/Guardian will sign-in/out their child daily. (campers will not be able to sign for themselves or any under aged sibling)
3. Camp Fees are due on or before Monday of each week (pay by check, cash, credit card, or money order). Nonpayment means my child may be dropped from the program.
4. Weekly camp fees are not prorated - \$65 for 1 day - \$65 for 3+ days
5. For field trips there will be a fee included per child, failure to pay the fee may result in the child not being able to participate in the field trips. Non participation in the field trip requires that you keep your child home for the day.
6. On major holidays **the camp is closed** so you must find other means of care for that day.
7. Children will not run, hit, push, throw objects, or treat anyone with disrespect or cause bodily harm. No yelling at or teasing, foul language, bullying or spitting at other campers. (Please explain and practice good sportsmanship with your child).
– excessive disobedience will result in your child’s expulsion from the program.
8. Parents/Guardians are responsible for damages to property and/or equipment (if the child was wrong in their action and action was intentional)
9. Children will always listen to the staff and do what is asked – if there is a problem between staff and camper instruct your child to talk to the Supervisor.
10. Children will obey the camp guidelines, such as the boundaries, bathroom policies, and use of park equipment.
11. If a camper has a problem with another camper he/she will tell the staff to immediately resolve the issue and practice restorative justice strategies.
